I still hope you people find a way - as you Carla have pointed out - to find the money for the tickets.

The public that is attending the Congress is waiting for our conferences...

I don't know if it is clear to the organizers of the Congress the grave situation that faces them?

What do you think will be the public reaction when they see they traveled to Lima for nothing, just the round-tables?!?

That they spent their money (or the money from their agencies and universities) in tickets, hotels, meals, etc... for nothing!?!

That they took a live from their professional duties, and from their families... for nothing?!?!

for nothing?!?

it is not only my presentation that is at stake here, you see? Not at all!!! It is ours, of everyone of us!

If I were in the organizer's shoes, where my academic good name would be at stake, I would certainly find a solution - I would sell my car, take a loan at a bank, and so on. There are plenty of solutions to avoid the complete disaster that is coming.

If you really would find a way to reintegrate my money once I'll be in Lima, I am sure you can find a way to buy our tickets by tomorrow morning.

one more thing: for months my contact with Carlos Vildoso was easy and fast, but since last week he does not answer any email...

this is not an atitude one expects from an academic that believes he can organize an international symposium.

I really hope to meet you all by Tuesday at Lima
